- You can understand **sentences and frequently used expressions** related to areas of familiar experience (basic information about yourself and your family, shopping, places of interest, occupations, etc.).
- You can communicate with local people about simple, everyday matters in simple and direct exchanges on familiar or routine matters.
- You can describe in simple terms, **aspects of your present life** and your environment as well as matters related to your immediate needs.

- By the end of level B1, you will be able to interact and make yourself understood in a variety of situations; state a problem, express an opinion, ask for clarification, make complaints; express yourself simply in the past tense and explain future events and plans.
- You will be able to understand the main points of clear standard texts on different matters.
- You can describe experiences, events, wishes and aspirations. Explain the advantages and disadvantages of an issue, speculate on possible hypothetical situations; converse naturally, fluently and effectively.

LISTENINGS

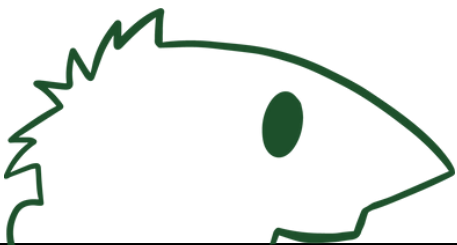
We will listen to the best audio series of and the most listened podcasts.

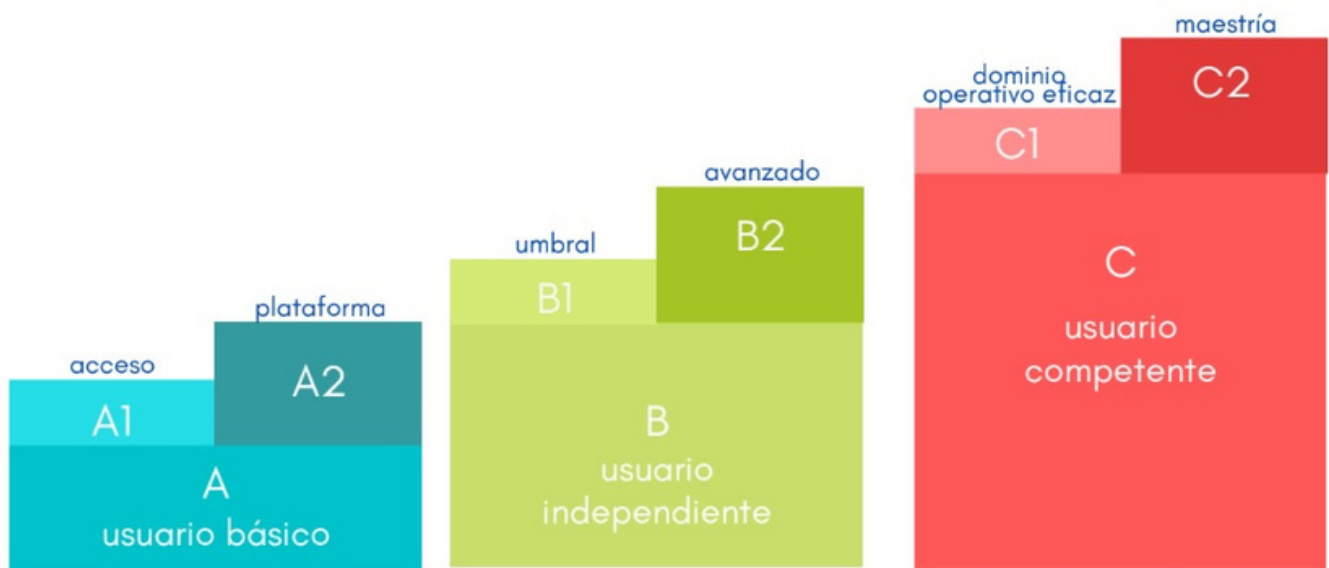
